Winemaking

LeChâteau Barrail Saint André is run by Agnés Coutant and her son Paul. Since 2014 Hubert de Bouard (Château Angélus) advises us in the elaboration of our wine.

This wine is the result of a strict plot selection, combining a unique terroir, and an particular attention to the vine.

After being harvested and carefully sorted, the grapes are vatted for 3 weeks to carry out the alcoholic fermentation. The wine is then matured in French oak barrels for 12 months with 50% new barrels and 50% one wine barrels. The vineyard is certified HVE (High Environmental Value) level 3 since 2019.

Tasting

The wine has a dense and deep ruby color with nice purple reflections. The nose is powerful and complex with beautiful notes of fruit, the wood is racy and soft. The mouth is silky, velvety and gives way to a beautiful ripe and smooth tannic structure.

Food pairing

This wine will go perfectly with grilled meats (pork, beef, veal). The long and silky tannins go perfectly with dishes in sauces. Château Barrail Saint André will accompany your most beautiful tables from now on. It can also be kept for about ten years.



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
